Current knowledge on ocean acidification supports the assumption that consequences will have large impact on the marine ecosystem and will be directly affecting the marine food web. Potential loss of biodiversity therefore present a real threat with long term effects on marine environment. As acidification research in marine ecosystems is still in its infancy, more studies are required to answer the numerous questions related to its biological and biogeochemical consequences.
